How to Clean Drills

- After use you must spray all outside parts of the drill off with a water hose to eliminate any soils remaining on the discs or any other parts of the drill
- It is the users responsibility to remove any unused seed from hopper and tubes, (this is best done with an air compressor or shop vacuum)
- using water to clean the tubes and hopper can cause buildup and mold.

What is No-Till?

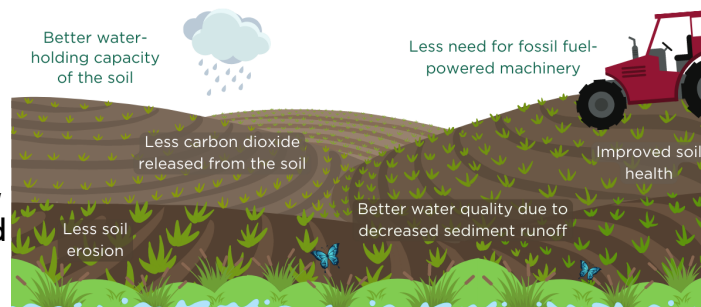
Planting crops or pasture directly into a field with no additional tillage performed after harvesting the previous crop (Generally corn, soybean, or grain). No-till farming decreases the amount of soil erosion traditional tillage causes in certain soil types.

Why No-Till?

- improves soil quality
- minimizes runoff, leaching, & soil erosion
- enhances water quality
- increases biological activity & soil microorganisms
- saves on fuel costs
